1. What is new in Vorarlberg's ski areas

More snow reliability in Schröcken

The Schröcken ski lifts in the Warth-Schröcken ski area in the Bregenzerwald are expanding their snowmaking facilities. From winter 2025/26, the black Flühli run on the Saloberkopf can also be fully covered with artificial snow. This ensures the best skiing conditions, especially at the start and end of the season.

"Hohes-Licht" lift in Damüls

The Damüls-Mellau ski resort in the Bregenzerwald is opening the 2025/26 winter season with the modernized "Hohes Licht" lift. Instead of a 2-seater chairlift that was in operation for over 50 years, there is now a 6-seater chairlift. The valley station was also rebuilt and relocated so that it is more accessible for skiers and can be reached from two sides.

Loischkopfbahn in Brandnertal

The new Loischkopfbahn will go into operation in Brandnertal at the start of the 2025/26 winter season. The 10-passenger gondola lift replaces two chairlifts and takes skiers to the slopes faster and more comfortably. The journey from the Tschengla near Bürserberg to the Loischkopf takes just eight minutes. The lift operates all year round and in summer it is possible to take bikes and pushchairs in the gondolas. The newly built valley station will be the central access point to the skiing, hiking and biking area.

Hochjoch: Kapellrestaurant 2.0 - reopening

At the start of the 2025/26 winter season, the Kapellrestaurant 2.0, which was modernized in summer 2025, will open on the Hochjoch in Silvretta Montafon. The gourmet and adventure restaurant at 1,850 metres above sea level combines traditional cuisine with modern hospitality. New features include a wine bar and fire lounge. The cozy "Stüberl" (Inn) and the spacious sun terraces have been renovated and extended. A contemporary architectural concept with lift and extended outdoor areas creates additional comfort. The restaurant can be reached via the Hochjoch and Zamang cable cars.

Erlebnisberg Golm: Panoramarestaurant Grüneck

The Panoramarestaurant Grüneck, a family-friendly and modern mountain restaurant, will open on the Erlebnisberg Golm in Montafon in December 2025. It includes an à la carte restaurant that is open all year round, a self-order restaurant and a restaurant area for school groups and ski school courses. Cable cars in Kleinwalsertal modernize

The cable cars in the cross-border Kleinwalsertal-Oberstdorf ski area have put together an extensive modernization package worth around 200 million euros spanning several years. From winter 2025/26, the Kanzelwand valley slope in Kleinwalsertal will be wider and can be covered with artificial snow. The snowmaking system on the Heuberg has also been optimized. In Oberstdorf, the modernized Fellhornbahn I reduces possible waiting times. The new gondolas with floor-to-ceiling windows travel faster.

NEW ACCOMMODATION & RESTAURANTS

Individual: Studio 17 in Bregenz

Studio 17 opened at Montfortstraße 17 in the center of Bregenz in June 2025. The renovated, around 100-year-old building houses 13 individually furnished studios ranging in size from 22 m² to 44 m². Each studio has its own color concept and is equipped with stylish furniture, wooden floors and a kitchenette. The studios and the house are accessible by code. Guests can prepare their own breakfast or choose one of the nearby cafés. A special feature of the house is a publicly accessible gallery that shows works by illustrators in changing exhibitions. This was the idea of the host couple, who are passionate about art and beautiful design.

Regional: Anna in Rankweil

Living history in Hard

Gustav Klimt and Vorarlberg

In Hohenems, the private Arche Noah collection of textile entrepreneur Hans Bäumler displays over 100 masterpieces by artists such as Spitzweg, Waldmüller, Monet, Renoir, Gauguin and Picasso. The collection also presents special exhibitions. From 27 September 2025 to 6 January 2026, the exhibition "Gustav Klimt and Vorarlberg" will shed light on the connections between the famous artist Gustav Klimt and Vorarlberg for the first time. Particular attention is put on Klimt's friendship with Dornbirn textile manufacturer Julius Rhomberg. Among other things, Art Nouveau fabrics from the Rhomberg company are on display, which were created at the time based on designs from Klimt's circle.

Since its opening, the cable car, which has been modernized several times, has been in tireless operation. In 2023, the cable car welcomed its 40 millionth passenger.
