## Creative design & cultural diversity

From the Bregenz Festival to impressive exhibitions and the Montafoner Resonanzen, Vorarlberg offers a wide range of cultural events for culture enthusiasts. The building culture, which combines architecture, craftsmanship and lifestyle, is particularly influential.

### Surprising buildings

Preserving the old and creating the new - this principle characterizes Vorarlberg's architecture. With a sense of tradition and innovation, contemporary, locally-rooted buildings are created, often setting an example through public projects. This is how a building culture of international standing has developed: museums, schools, municipal offices, cultural centres, hotels and restaurants bear witness to this.

A particular example is the BUS:STOP Krumbach stations in the Bregenzerwald - designed by seven architectural firms from seven countries and implemented by regional craftspeople.
