### Bodensee Card PLUS

The Bodensee Card PLUS is ideal for discovery tours around Lake Constance. It is valid all year round and offers free admission to around 160 excursion destinations (around 60 in winter) as well as free travel on Lake Constance's scheduled boats.

It also serves as a ticket for buses and trains in the region and offers discounts with numerous bonus partners. It is available for 3 or 7 flexibly selectable days.
