1. What's new in Vorarlberg's ski areas

New Albonabahn I ropeway in Stuben am Arlberg

In the Ski Arlberg resort the new Albonabahn I, an 8-seater monocable gondola ropeway, will replace the old double chairlift on almost the same route. The new ropeway offers skiers added convenience and a connection to Alpe Rauz as well as access to the ski areas of St. Anton, St. Christoph (both Tyrol), Zürs and Lech (both Vorarlberg). The mountain terminal will be moved some 200 metres further down and is now immediately next to the Albona Mitte mountain restaurant.

Additional snow-making facilities for the Schröcken ski lifts

The Schröcken ski lifts in the ski area of Warth-Schröcken in Bregenzerwald will be expanding their snow-making facilities in the area around Auenfeld. Skiers will now be able to descend to the valley terminal of Saloberlift also if the winter seasons starts off with poor snow conditions. The ski area lies at an altitude of approx. 1,400 to 2,000 metres. The season is set to start on 8 December 2023. www.warth-schroecken.at/en

NEW ACCOMMODATION & RESTAURANTS

Balma Lech, Lech am Arlberg

In December 2023, the apartment house Balma is set to open in the hamlet of Zug, featuring an à-la-carte restaurant. It accommodates five apartments ranging from 54 m² to 149 m² in size and sleeping up to four. Designer furniture, an open fire and a private sauna lend a stylish but cosy atmosphere to every unit. As an extra treat, your fridge will be filled with selected delicacies from the region upon your arrival. Breakfast served on request. www.balma.at

Hof 30, Schwarzenberg

In August 2023, "Hof 30" opened in Schwarzenberg in the very heart of the village. The timber construction in typical Bregenzerwald-style accommodates two lofts. The 180 m² Hof loft sleeps up to six, while the 90 m² Tobl loft sleeps a maximum of 4. Alpenstolz Apartments, Damüls

Ever since August 2023, the 39 Alpenstolz Apartments have been open to visitors. Luxuriously furnished, the units are spread over four buildings. You can choose between apartments with two, three or four rooms. The largest apartments sleep up to eight persons. Fresh-roll service for breakfast

Sonnberg Appartements, Schröcken

The Sonnberg Appartements are set to open in late 2023 in Schröcken in Bregenzerwald. The 17 holiday apartments vary between 48 m² and 76 m² in size and are divided among two buildings with an underground car park. All units feature a balcony. There is sauna in the basement. The bus to the Warth-Schröcken ski area stops right on the doorstep. Hotel Blaue Rose, Feldkirch

The self-check-in boutique hotel Blaue Rose opens in Feldkirch in December 2023. The small hotel is located in a carefully renovated 500-year-old house in the town centre. All the work was carried out by craftsmen from the region. The "Blaue Rose" has 18 individually furnished rooms, ranging from 10 m² economy single rooms to 21 m² family rooms. REDESIGNS/EXTENSIONS/MAJOR RENOVATIONS

Hotel Hirschen, Schwarzenberg

The Fetz family, landlords at Hotel Hirschen in Schwarzenberg, have high-flying plans: In early 2023, a facelift of six rooms and suites was completed. In a next step, 21 rooms will be converted into spacious apartments. Right next to the elegant Bregenzerwald building whose history dates back to the 17th century, a bathhouse with saunas and outdoor pool is being built. All around, a bliss-filled garden will invite guests to linger for a while. The new apartments will be completed by early 2024.

Hotel Gretina, Bezau

Hotel Gretina in Bezau in Bregenzerwald opened in 2017. The landlords have now taken over the neighbouring building and are fitting two 60 m² apartments and a 45 m² studio there. Each of the three units sleep two. The large apartments are on the first floor and feature a loggia. The studio comes with garden use. The new apartments can be booked starting January 2024.

Posthotel Taube, Schruns

Posthotel Taube has been central to village life in Schruns ever since 1840. Famous guests of the hotel include Ernest Hemingway, who spent some weeks with his family here in the winters of 1924/25 and 1925/26. Following a serious facelift and redesign, this tradition-steeped hotel is set to reopen on 1 December 2023 as a four-star superior hotel. The main building, the historic Posthotel Traube, features three à-la-carte restaurant lounges and some of the 48 luxuriously equipped rooms and suites. The highly popular *Tauben* garden and *Tauben* bar, formerly *Tauben* cellar, will be reopened as well. The new Alpgues Haus adjacent to the main building accommodates a spa and a wellness complex. The new Nescherina tract features two rooms for workshops and meetings. In addition, the owners are building three well-equipped team chalets for their staff in Tschagguns. www.posthotel-taube.at/en

Löwen Hotel Montafon, Schruns

Since January 2023, Löwen Hotel Montafon has been welcoming guests with 23 additional rooms, flexible conference spaces, a novel gastronomic offer and inspiring interior design. The new *Haus Montafon* tract boasts new rooms as well as several conference facilities such as *Saal Montafon*, which, at 200 m², offers the largest conference venue in the valley. Tanzcafé Arlberg on the entire Arlberg for the first time

Just in time for the 10th edition, the Tanzcafé, which was previously based in Lech Zürs, is now taking place across the entire Arlberg region. This means that snow-loving concert fans can also enjoy the stylish open-air festival in St. Christoph, St. Anton and Stuben. Tanzcafé Arlberg will take place from 31 March to 14 April 2024. STAGE Bregenz – Fair for contemporary art and collective design

Wintery Bregenz will be the venue of a premiere: the first "STAGE Bregenz – Fair for contemporary and collective design" will be hosted from 22-25 February 2024 at Festspielhaus Bregenz. New location for Haus Habakuk, Bludenz

Kasperl, Helmi and magician Tintifax were the much-worshipped TV stars of many Austrians when they were young. The puppets were manufactured by Arminio Rothstein, better known as Clown Habakuk. After the demise of Arminio Rothstein, Christian Mair, a Vorarlberg puppet player and cabaret artist, was able to acquire these puppets. In 2022, he set up a small puppet atelier and exhibition in Bludenz. In October 2023, Christian Mair and his puppets moved into a much larger building in the centre of Bludenz. The new site accommodates a larger exhibition and atelier, as well as a stage for live performances, and the Habakuk café. www.habakuk.at

Exhibitions in Vorarlberg's museums in the winter season 2023/24

- Brazilian-born artist Solange Pessoa uses materials such as soil, moss, wax, leather, blood and feathers. Her works are on display at *Kunsthaus Bregenz* from 11 November 2023 to 4 February 2024. www.kunsthaus-bregenz.at/en
- "The Canapé is my Pleasure" is the title of a special exhibition at the vorarlberg museum from 11 November to spring 2024. It revolves around Biedermeier-era lounge furniture from Bregenzerwald. Effective as of 1 February 2024, a new museum director has been appointed. Michael Kasper, formerly head of the Montafon museums, will follow Andreas Rudigier, who is to take over the management of the Tirol State Museums. www.vorarlbergmuseum.at/en
- The Women's Museum Hittisau is Austria's only museum devoted to women and documents cultural creation by women. "Spick and Span" is the ultra-clean title of the current exhibition on show at two sites: in Hittisau and in the Lech Museum in Lech am Arlberg. Until 27 October 2024 the central theme is cleaning inside, outside, everywhere, and aspects of cleaning and cleanliness, role models and ecology. www.frauenmuseum.at
- Up until 10 March 2024, the *Jewish Museum Hohenems* will be showcasing the photo documentation "A Place of Our Own" by the Israeli artist and photographer Iris Hassid, who accompanied four young Arab students in Tel Aviv in their day-to-day lives. The outcome makes the many different facets of contemporary Arab identity in Israel visible. www.jm-hohenems.at/en



• The Vorarlberg FIS Ski Museum Damüls, a small museum in the former vicarage of Damüls, focuses on local history and winter sports. Since 2017, the museum has been certified by the FIS and is thus Vorarlberg's only FIS Ski Museum. Exhibits, mainly collected by Christian Lingenhöle from Bregenz, provide insights into the over 100-year ski history of the village. In addition to historic skis, the focus is on equipment and a colourful selection of memorabilia.
On the 2nd floor, the new biennial special exhibition "Nona" is dedicated to the multifaceted potential of swinging: at scenic spots in Damüls and in the neighbouring villages of Fontanella Faschina in the Großes Walsertal Biosphere Park, large wooden swings invite visitors to swing. Why the swings are located in the mountains and how we can find relaxation in digital times through swinging is explained to visitors on a tour.

The "Tisch Zwölf" concept combines a sustainable, healthy and delicious lunch with new networking opportunities. Another aspect is important to the initiators, who include restaurant owners and vegetable producers: "We want to change the future," they say. Their goal is to make communal catering fit for the future. This is to be achieved with well-prepared regional, seasonal food and dining options in special places. Once a week, "Tisch Zwölf" is staged in Andelsbuch in Bregenzerwald, and once at CampusVäre in Dornbirn. Seven mountain farms from Lech, Zug, Oberlech and Zürs have joined forces and founded the "Echt Lech" association in a bid to showcase their day-to-day life with the animals on the steep mountain slopes on the Arlberg. They sell their specialities under the label "Echt Lech", ranging from fresh hay milk to pork, beef and poultry and various sausages. New LED lighting at Kunsthaus Bregenz

In early 2023, Kunsthaus Bregenz (KUB) replaced all its lights with LEDs as part of its energy efficiency programme, which has been running for several years. On the three upper floors alone, 660 lamps were refitted. The lighting on the escape routes and basement floors was replaced as well. Thanks to these measures and daylight-dependent regulation, Kunsthaus Bregenz will in future be able to save more than 50 per cent of the electricity previously consumed for lighting.
