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## 1. Winter in Full Swing

Vorarlberg is one of the birthplaces of Alpine skiing, where the art of gliding down the slopes has been cultivated and consistently improved since the beginning of the 20<sup>th</sup> century. This small region in the west of Austria has brought forth innovations such as heated seats on chairlifts, to name but one. Visitors have ample choices when it comes to enjoying Vorarlberg's winter wonderland – from groomed slopes to ski touring, from freeriding to cross-country skiing, from winter hiking to snow-shoe tours. And the winter season also has pleasurable experiences in store beside the spectacular landscape – architectural and cultural attractions as well as culinary delights await.

## Ski Destination Vorarlberg – plenty of variety within easy reach

Vorarlberg looks back on a long tradition as a pioneer of alpine skiing – more than 110 years ago, the very foundations of Alpine skiing were laid here at the Arlberg. Since then, the mountains have been developed on a human scale. Most ski areas extend up to snow-sure altitudes of 1,400 to 2,400m. Taking home a plethora of new impressions is an easy feat in Vorarlberg. Distances are short, regional ski passes offer plenty of flexibility, and an excellent network of regular train and bus services or ski shuttles makes it easy to move around.

The winter landscape skiers will encounter is truly spectacular. From the mountain terminals in Damüls-Mellau and on Diedamskopf in Bregenzerwald, you can see as far as Lake Constance, while on the Arlberg, in Montafon, in Kleinwalsertal, Brandnertal and Klostertal, sweeping vistas of the mountains of Vorarlberg and its neighbouring countries unfold. In Kleinwalsertal, skiing fun is truly "boundless", as the ski area encompasses pistes in both Austria and in Germany. Ski Arlberg, which straddles Vorarlberg and Tirol, is the currently largest interconnected ski area in Austria. The Silvretta Skisafari takes skiers from Montafon to Tirol and back again.

Variety also means that Vorarlberg's ski areas feature slopes to accommodate all levels of proficiency. Many ski resorts also offer varied combinations of groomed and ungroomed runs, and distances are short, which is an added bonus. Some villages, such as Oberlech, Damüls-Mellau im Bregenzerwald and Brandnertal, are perfect ski-in – ski-out destinations. www.vorarlberg.travel/skiing

## More fun activities in the snow

On the winter hiking trails criss-crossing all of Vorarlberg, you can choose between cleared or groomed trails. Various locations offer guided snowshoe tours throughout the day and even at night. Bregenzerwald and Brandnertal boast plenty of attractive cross-country destinations, while Vorarlberg's highest cross-country trails can be found on Silvretta-Bielerhöhe in Montafon, at 2,032m altitude. Toboggan runs are widely available and always worth a try. Some are even illuminated for night-time fun. Or you might fancy going out on a husky sledge trip or spending a night in an igloo high up in the mountains.



## Architectural and cultural attractions

A traditional Vorarlberg timber house here, a state-of-the-art new build there – made from timber, too, it goes without saying – this surprising mix of a traditional and contemporary design is a feature typically encountered in many towns and villages. Vorarlberg, this small region at the westernmost tip of Austria, has long become an acclaimed showcase of contemporary (timber) architecture in the Alps.

No matter where, in small villages or in ski resorts, examples of noteworthy contemporary architecture range from cableway terminals to mountain-top restaurants and lodges to hotels, some of the most outstanding among them the ski lodge "Der Wolf", the Balmalpe restaurant in Lech Zürs am Arlberg, the valley and mountain terminals of the Mellau cableway in Bregenzerwald, the Frööd restaurant in the ski area of Brand im Bregenzerwald, the Alpine sports centre in Schruns in Montafon or the mountain terminal of the Nebelhornbahn cableway in the cross-border ski area of Kleinwalsertal-Oberstdorf. www.vorarlberg.travel/architecture

"Firnklang Brandnertal" will have 9 live bands playing at 9 restaurants every Sunday in March 2022. ## 2. Innovations & New Features for Cableways

## Valisera cableway, Silvretta Montafon

The end of February 2021 witnessed the Valisera cableway in Montafon closing down after 40 years of operation. In the category "commercial building", recognitions in 2021 went to the Enz campsite in Dornbirn, which built two single-story wooden pavilions as an entrance, and to the Tempel 74 apartment building in Mellau for its detailed new construction. In the category "multi-family house", the staff house of the Hotel Biberkopf in Warth, a stacking of 43 wooden modules, received recognition. The new entrance area of the Lochau Strandbad lido, which also houses the changing rooms, toilets and a café, received recognition in the "Public Building" category. The vacation home "Unser Vorsäß" in Schwarzenberg, which was rebuilt in an exemplary manner, received

In the 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> centuries, master builders, stucco artists and craftspeople from Bregenzerwald had a hand in erecting close to 800 Baroque buildings in Southern Germany, Switzerland and Alsace. For the most part, these were churches and monasteries, but there were palaces, manor houses and town houses among them as well. Many of these master builders and craftspeople came from Au, where a guild had been formed.

The new museum in Au-Schoppernau now places a spotlight on the masters of this era and their remarkable achievements. The "Kurathus" in Au-Rehmen, carefully renovated by local craftspeople, will host the new museum. Built in 1780, it was the home of a portrait and miniature painter who was well-known at the time. Later, it came into the possession of the church and provided accommodation for the respective curate or parish priest. The museum at "Kurathus" will open its doors on 26 September 2021.

The four themes of the exhibition are Planning, designing and building; Organising construction work; Mobile and interconnected; and Leaving and staying. barockbaumeister.at
